Stephanie's Brine Baths Campaign Takes off

As responses to our community survey flood in showing tremendous support for the Brine Baths, Stephanie Vale has enlisted the help of the Droitwich Standard in running a supporting petition. Her letter to the papers had earlier brought action from former SALT members. Their petition raised over 2,000 signatures on Salt Day alone.

Stephanie says "I hope Wychavon and the lease holders of the Brine Baths site take notice of what local people are saying. In answering my question to Wychavon's Executive Board, Cllr Paul Middlebrough pointed out that the Council did not own or operate the Brine Baths. They in effect 'gave away' the site to the private hospital in 1985 on a 125 year lease. Unbelievably they also signed away the brine baths by only requiring the hospital to provide a brine facility for 25 years. That time is up next year. Time is fast running out for the brine baths."

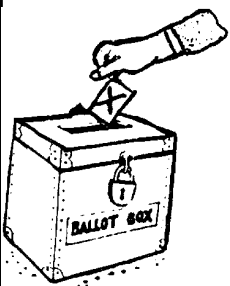
